In the Spring of 1986, Mitch Morgenstern had an inspiration to honor the memory of longtime friend, mentor and O.A. brother, Jack Kohler. Jack had passed away a few years earlier. A longtime 'institution' at Ten Mile River and in Suanhacky Lodge, how to honor Jack's memory would of course have to someway includes these aspects of his life.

Jack had been a camper at TMR, a Camp Scoutmaster, Staffman, and Camp Director in addition to being a two tenured Lodge Advisor of Suanhacky Lodge and the first Area Advisor for the New York City 5 Lodges.

It was decided that a very nice way to honor Jack, was to help keep his camp, TMR and his Lodge, Suanhacky strong and growing.

A way to do that was to be sure all Scouts got an opportunity camp at TMR. Campership assistance, money to offset the ever-growing camp fees, so that Scouts who may otherwise not get a chance to go to camp, could afford to, seemed to be a solution that filled the bill. Scouts going to camp, would then be eligible to be selected for induction to Suanhacky, promoting camp and thus, servicing camp.

Since then more than 550 Scouts have been awarded Kohler Camperships.

This coming year, 2006 will mark our 20th Anniversary of 'Helping Make Every Scout a Camper'. We plan to have an anniversary luncheon on Sunday October 29, 2006, so mark your calendars. (We have not finalized a location yet however). We will be awarding our "Outstanding Scouter Award of Excellence" as well as going down memory lane.
