30th ANNIVERSARY OF REDEDICATION OF THE TOWER OF FRIENDSHIP

This year marks the 30th Anniversary of the repairing and rededication of the TOWER OF FRIENDSHIP on Crystal Lake.

In 1986, brothers of Suanhacky Lodge, under direction of Henry Joerz and Russ Maerz repaired the tower that had been damaged from years of weathering and vandalism. Rocks were secures, a new scout head put on the top and some landscaping done. (FYI; The original scout head was a Norman Rockwell sculpture, with Vincent Kohler, Jack's older brother being the model for it).

When the ceremony was held to rededicate the Tower, a plaque was put on the base, declaring it was done on fond memory of JACK KOHLER. If you visit TMR, please stop by the tower and pay your respects.
